CERTIFICATION OF REPRESENTATIVE

Pursuant to a Direction of Election previously issued by it in the above-captioned matter, the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission, on May 4, 2023, conducted an election, pursuant to § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act, to determine whether employees of the Marshall Public Schools, in the collective bargaining unit set forth in the Commission's Direction, desired to be represented by the Marshall Education Association, WEAC Region 6, for the purpose of collective bargaining with the Marshall Public Schools.

The result of the election was as follows:

1.	Total number eligible to vote	97
2.	Total ballots cast	69
3.	Total valid ballots counted	69
4.	Ballots cast for Marshall Education Association, WEAC Region 6	65
5.	Ballots cast for no representation	4

NOW, THEREFORE, by virtue of and pursuant to the power vested in the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission by § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act;

IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED that the Marshall Education Association, WEAC Region 6 has been selected by at least fifty-one percent (51%) of all eligible employees in the collective

bargaining unit consisting of all regular full-time and regular part-time professional employees, including, but not limited to, teachers, nurses, social workers, counselors, school psychologists, speech/language pathologists, occupational and physical therapists, but excluding supervisory, managerial and confidential employees and all other employees., as their representative; and that pursuant to the provisions of § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act said Labor Organization is the exclusive collective bargaining representative of all such employees for the purpose of collective bargaining with the Marshall Public Schools.
