**CERTIFICATION OF REPRESENTATIVE**

Pursuant to a Direction of Election previously issued by it in the above-captioned matter, the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission, on July 10, 2023, conducted an election, pursuant to § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act, to determine whether employees of the School District of Altoona, in the collective bargaining unit set forth in the Commission's Direction, desired to be represented by the WEAC Region 1, for the purpose of collective bargaining with the School District of Altoona.

The result of the election was as follows:

1.	Total number eligible to vote	114
2.	Total ballots cast	75
3.	Total valid ballots counted	75
4.	Ballots cast for WEAC Region 1	73
5.	Ballots cast for no representation	2

NOW, THEREFORE, by virtue of and pursuant to the power vested in the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission by § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act;

IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED that the WEAC Region 1 has been selected by at least fifty-one percent (51%) of all eligible employees in the collective bargaining unit consisting of all regular full-time and regular part-time teachers employed by the School District of Altoona,

excluding supervisors, managerial, and confidential employees, as their representative; and that pursuant to the provisions of § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act said Labor Organization is the exclusive collective bargaining representative of all such employees for the purpose of collective bargaining with the School District of Altoona.
