CERTIFICATION OF ELECTION RESULTS

Pursuant to a Direction of Election previously issued by it in the above-captioned matter, the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission, on August 21, 2023, conducted an election, pursuant to § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act, to determine whether employees of the Village of Marathon City, in the collective bargaining unit set forth in the Commission's Direction, desired to be represented by the General Teamsters Union Local No. 662, for the purpose of collective bargaining with the Village of Marathon City.

The result of the election was as follows:

NOW, THEREFORE, by virtue of and pursuant to the power vested in the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission by § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act;

IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED that a majority of all eligible employees who voted at said election in the collective bargaining unit consisting of all full-time police officers and sergeants

employed by the Village of Marathon City Police Department, excluding the Chief of Police, supervisory, managerial, and confidential employees, failed to select General Teamsters Union Local No. 662, as their bargaining representative.
