CERTIFICATION OF REPRESENTATIVE

Pursuant to a Direction of Election previously issued by it in the above-captioned matter, the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission, on August 25, 2023, conducted an election, pursuant to § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act, to determine whether employees of the Madison Metropolitan School District, in the collective bargaining unit set forth in the Commission's Direction, desired to be represented by the Building and Construction Trades Council of South Central Wisconsin, for the purpose of collective bargaining with the Madison Metropolitan School District.

The result of the election was as follows:

NOW, THEREFORE, by virtue of and pursuant to the power vested in the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission by § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act;

IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED that the Building and Construction Trades Council of South Central Wisconsin has been selected by at least fifty-one percent (51%) of all eligible employees in the collective bargaining unit consisting of all regular full time and regular part time carpenters, painters, steamfitters, plumbers and electricians employed by the Madison Metropolitan School District. Employees excluded from this collective bargaining unit are all administrative, managerial, supervisory, confidential, professional, custodial, food service, clerical and technical and teacher aide employees, as their representative; and that pursuant to the provisions of § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act said Labor Organization is the exclusive collective bargaining representative of all such employees for the purpose of collective bargaining with the Madison Metropolitan School District.
