CERTIFICATION OF REPRESENTATIVE

Pursuant to a Direction of Election previously issued by it in the above-captioned matter, the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission, on October 16, 2023, conducted an election pursuant to § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act, to determine whether employees of the Town of Oconomowoc, in the collective bargaining unit set forth in the Commission's Direction, desired to be represented by either the Town of Oconomowoc Professional Police Officers' Association or by the Wisconsin Professional Police Association or by neither of said Labor Organizations, for the purpose of collective bargaining with the Town of Oconomowoc.

The result of the election was as follows:

1. Total number eligible to vote	11
2. Total ballots cast	10
3. Total valid ballots counted	10
4. Ballots cast for Town of Oconomowoc Professional Police Officers' Association	10
5. Ballots cast for Wisconsin Professional Police Association	0
5. Ballots cast for no representation	0

NOW, THEREFORE, by virtue of and pursuant to the power vested in the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission by § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act;

IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED that the Town of Oconomowoc Professional Police Officers' Association has been selected by a majority of all members of the Town of Oconomowoc Police Department who have the power to make arrests, including matrons, if any, but excluding the Chief of Police, the Lieutenant, non-sworn clerical employees, all part-time employees, and managerial, supervisory, and confidential employees, as their representative; and that pursuant to the provisions of § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act said Labor Organization is the exclusive collective bargaining representative of all such employees for the purpose of collective bargaining with the Town of Oconomowoc.
