CERTIFICATION OF REPRESENTATIVE

Pursuant to a Direction of Election previously issued by it in the above-captioned matter, the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission, on November 6, 2023, conducted an election pursuant to § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act, to determine whether employees of the City of Ashland, in the collective bargaining unit set forth in the Commission's Direction, desired to continue to be represented by the Wisconsin Professional Police Association, or desired to be represented by the Ashland Professional Police Officers' Association, or by neither of said Labor Organizations for the purpose of collective bargaining with the City of Ashland.

The result of the election was as follows:

5.	Ballots cast for Wisconsin Professional Police Association	0

NOW, THEREFORE, by virtue of and pursuant to the power vested in the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission by § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act;

IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED that the Ashland Professional Police Officers' Association has been selected by a majority of all eligible employees who voted at said election in the collective bargaining unit consisting of all sworn law enforcement personnel employed by the City of Ashland, excluding the Chief of Police, Operations Captain, managerial, supervisory, and confidential employees as their representative; and that pursuant to the provisions of § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act the Ashland Professional Police Officers' Association is the exclusive collective bargaining representative of all such employees for the purpose of collective bargaining with the City of Ashland.
