CERTIFICATION OF REPRESENTATIVE

Pursuant to a Direction of Election previously issued by it in the above-captioned matter, the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission, on December 7, 2023, conducted an election, pursuant to § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act, to determine whether employees of the Columbus School District, in the collective bargaining unit set forth in the Commission's Direction, desired to be represented by the Columbus Education Association, for the purpose of collective bargaining with the Columbus School District.

The result of the election was as follows:

1.	Total number eligible to vote	107
2.	Total ballots cast	73
3.	Total valid ballots counted	71
4.	Ballots cast for Columbus Education Association	69
5.	Ballots cast for no representation	2

NOW, THEREFORE, by virtue of and pursuant to the power vested in the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission by § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act;

IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED that the Columbus Education Association has been selected by at least fifty-one percent (51%) of all eligible employees in the collective bargaining unit

consisting of all regular full-time and regular part-time professional employees of the District engaged in teaching, including classroom teachers, health occupations instructors, librarians, guidance counselors, school psychologists, school social workers and school nurses, but excluding supervisory, managerial and confidential employees, as their representative; and that pursuant to the provisions of § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act said Labor Organization is the exclusive collective bargaining representative of all such employees for the purpose of collective bargaining with the Columbus School District.
