**CERTIFICATION OF REPRESENTATIVE**

Pursuant to a Direction of Election previously issued by it in the above-captioned matter, the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission, on February 22, 2024, conducted an election, pursuant to § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act, to determine whether employees of the Abbotsford School District, in the collective bargaining unit set forth in the Commission's Direction, desired to be represented by the Abbotsford Education Association, WEAC Region 2, for the purpose of collective bargaining with the Abbotsford School District.

The result of the election was as follows:

1.	Total number eligible to vote	59
2.	Total ballots cast	44
3.	Total valid ballots counted	42
4.	Ballots cast for Abbotsford Education Association, WEAC Region 2	39
5.	Ballots cast for no representation	3

NOW, THEREFORE, by virtue of and pursuant to the power vested in the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission by § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act;

IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED that the Abbotsford Education Association, WEAC Region 2 has been selected by at least fifty-one percent (51%) of all eligible employees in the collective

bargaining unit consisting of all certified regular full-time and regular part-time classroom teachers under contract, on leave or employed by the Board, excluding managerial, confidential and supervisory employees; Regular Full-time Teachers are defined as teachers who carry a full-time load; Regular Part-time Teachers are defined as teachers who teach less than a full-time teaching load; as their representative; and that pursuant to the provisions of § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act said Labor Organization is the exclusive collective bargaining representative of all such employees for the purpose of collective bargaining with the Abbotsford School District.
