CERTIFICATION OF REPRESENTATIVE

Pursuant to a Direction of Election previously issued by it in the above-captioned matter, the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission, on May 23, 2024, conducted an election, pursuant to § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act, to determine whether employees of the Middleton-Cross Plains Area School District, in the collective bargaining unit set forth in the Commission's Direction, desired to be represented by the Middleton Education Association, WEAC Region 6, for the purpose of collective bargaining with the Middleton-Cross Plains Area School District.

The result of the election was as follows:

| 2. | Total ballots cast | 519 |
| 3. | Total valid ballots counted | 519 |
| 4. | Ballots cast for Middleton Education Association, WEAC Region 6 | 516 |
| 5. | Ballots cast for no representation | 3 |

NOW, THEREFORE, by virtue of and pursuant to the power vested in the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission by § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act;

IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED that the Middleton Education Association, WEAC Region 6 has been selected by at least fifty-one percent (51%) of all eligible employees in the collective bargaining unit consisting of all regular full-time and regular part-time professional employees of the Middleton-Cross Plains Area School District, including teachers, librarians, bilingual resource specialists, social workers, school counselors, nurses, occupational therapists, physical therapists, school psychologists, speech language pathologists, interventionists, instructional coaches, reading/math specialists, and diagnosticians, but excluding Administrators, Deans of Students, Directors, Coordinators, Supervisors, Managers, Special Education Coordinators, Student and Family Engagement Specialists, Math Tutors, casual substitutes and permanent substitutes, and confidential employees., as their representative; and that pursuant to the provisions of § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act said Labor Organization is the exclusive collective bargaining representative of all such employees for the purpose of collective bargaining with the Middleton-Cross Plains Area School District.
