**CERTIFICATION OF REPRESENTATIVE**

Pursuant to a Direction of Election previously issued by it in the above-captioned matter, the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission, on June 27, 2024, conducted an election, pursuant to § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act, to determine whether employees of the Blackhawk Technical College, in the collective bargaining unit set forth in the Commission's Direction, desired to be represented by the Blackhawk Technical Faculty Federation, AFT Local 2308 for the purpose of collective bargaining with the Blackhawk Technical College.

The result of the election was as follows:

1.	Total number eligible to vote	85
2.	Total ballots cast	52
3.	Total valid ballots counted	51
4.	Ballots cast for Blackhawk Technical Faculty Federation, AFT Local 2308	49
5.	Ballots cast for no representation	2

NOW, THEREFORE, by virtue of and pursuant to the power vested in the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission by § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act;

IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED that the Blackhawk Technical Faculty Federation, AFT Local 2308 has been selected by at least fifty-one percent (51%) of all eligible employees in the collective bargaining unit consisting of Full-time student-facing employees; specifically instructors, librarians, transfer coordinators, counselors, and advisors, as their representative; and that pursuant to the provisions of § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act said Labor Organization is the exclusive collective bargaining representative of all such employees for the purpose of collective bargaining with the Blackhawk Technical College.
