CERTIFICATION OF REPRESENTATIVE

Pursuant to a Direction of Election previously issued by it in the above-captioned matter, the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission, on August 19, 2024, conducted an election pursuant to § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act, to determine whether employees of Oconto County, in the collective bargaining unit set forth in the Commission's Direction, desired to be represented by either the Oconto County Sheriff's Deputies Association or by the Wisconsin Professional Police Association or by neither of said Labor Organizations, for the purpose of collective bargaining with Oconto County.

The result of the election was as follows:

5.	Ballots cast for Wisconsin Professional Police Association	0

NOW, THEREFORE, by virtue of and pursuant to the power vested in the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission by § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act;

IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED that the Oconto County Sheriff's Deputies Association has been selected by a majority of all eligible employees who voted at said election in the collective bargaining unit consisting of All full-time and regular part-time deputies and investigators of the Sheriff's Office employed by Oconto County excluding the Sheriff and the Chief Deputy, supervisory, managerial, confidential and other employees without the power of arrest, and all other employees, as their representative; and that pursuant to the provisions of § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act said Labor Organization is the exclusive collective bargaining representative of all such employees for the purpose of collective bargaining with Oconto County.
