CONSENT ARBITRATION AWARD

The above-captioned parties, herein "Association" and "City", are parties to a collective bargaining agreement providing for final and binding arbitration. Pursuant thereto, hearing was held in Oshkosh, Wisconsin, on September 18, 1997. A transcript was issued in the matter on October 7, 1997.

Thereafter, prior to submission of briefs in the case, the Association by letter dated November 11, 1997, informed the Arbitrator "that an agreement has been reached in regard to the above grievance. Consequently, on behalf of the Association, I am withdrawing this grievance." The parties then stipulated to a Consent Arbitration Award closing the file on the case.
