The Appellants, Larry Madsen and Myra Preston, were employed by the University of Wisconsin-Superior. On September 13, 1974, they filed their reclassification appeal with this Board. On October 4, 1974, Mr. James L. Greenwald, then Legal Counsel to the Board, acknowledged receipt of the Appellant's appeal and informed them that, as the classification involved in their appeal was a delegated action, their request for reclassification should first have been submitted to the University. Mr. Greenwald further informed the Appellants that their appeal materials had been forwarded to the University's Central Personnel Office for initial consideration. It appears that both Appellants were successful and were reclassified effective November 10, 1974. By letter of November 19, 1974, the Board's secretary requested that, if the action was not satisfactory to them, the Appellants advise the Board that they wished to proceed with their appeal. No response was forthcoming and, by letter of January 21, 1975, Appellants were informed that if they did not notify the Board within 10 days of the receipt of the letter that they wished to pursue their case, their appeal would be dismissed.

The 10-day period has elapsed, and the Appellants have to date failed to indicate in any way that they desire to pursue their appeal.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the above-captioned case is dismissed.
