This appeal involves the question whether the reduction in classification of certain positions upon a reorganization is a reallocation or a demotion in lieu of layoff.

The facts have been stipulated by the parties. We find the ultimate facts to be as follows:

- As a result of a reorganization at Northern and Southern Colony, the "Cottage Cluster" organizational concept has been replaced by the "Unit Management" concept.
- The need for those positions designated as Cottage Cluster Supervisors and classified as Institution Aids 5 has been eliminated with the establishment of Unit Managers. The need for lead workers (Institution Aids 3) will be eliminated with the additional utilization of Institution Aids 4 as first line supervisors.
- 3. This action will result in a reduction of the number of Aid 5 and Aid 3 positions and an increase in the number of Aid 4 and Aid 2 positions.

We conclude that this transaction involves a demotion of employees in lieu of their layoff occasioned by a reorganization. The employees have been moved from a position in a higher class to a different position in a lower class. Lyons v. Wettengel, Wis. Pers. Bd. Case No. 73-36, IT IS ORDERED that the action of the Respondent advising the Appellant to proceed with demotions in lieu of layoff is affirmed and the appeal is hereby dismissed.
