ORDER

WHEREAS, it was stipulated by and between the parties on August 14, 1975 that

1) The Department of Industry, Labor and Human Relations shall appoint Janet Heisse to a permanent full-time position as Equal Rights Officer - 4; pay range 12-05. This appointment shall be effective commencing August 11, 1975.

2) Janet Heisse, by her attorneys, will request that the Personnel Board investigate the appointing and hiring practices of the Department of Industry, Labor and Human Relations, Equal Rights Division.

3) Janet Heisse, by her attorneys, shall move for a dismissal of the above captioned action; and

WHEREAS, Appellant moved that the Personnel Board, pursuant to its authority under Section 16.05 (4), Wis. Stats., investigate the appointing and hiring practices of the Department of Industry, Labor and Human Relations, Equal Rights Division; and

WHEREAS, Appellant moves that the Personnel Board enter an order dismissing the above captioned appeal.


NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that upon all the files, records, and proceedings had heretofore herein and upon the stipulation of the parties the Appointing Authority of the Department of Industry, Labor and Human Relations by Robert Tyler, Administrator, shall appoint Janet Heisse to a position within the Department of Industry, Labor and Human Relations as Equal Rights Officer - 4; pay range 12-05 on a permanent, full-time classified service basis.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the Personnel Board shall consider Appellant's request for an investigation into the appointing and hiring practices of the Department of Industry, Labor and Human Relations, Equal Rights Division.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the above captioned appeal be dismissed.
