ORDER  
 OF  
 DISMISSAL

On September 6, 1974, Appellant, Effie Orth, appealed to the Board from the third-step denial of her grievance. It was the position of the Appellant, as set forth in her letter of appeal, that the employer had engaged in discriminatory practices because of the Appellant's Union affiliation, one result of which was to improperly deny to Appellant her request that she be reclassified to Typist III. On December 16, 1974, Mr. Ronald P. Orth, the Union representative, notified the Board through its secretary that Appellant in this case was going to withdraw her appeal. By letter of January 21, 1975, Appellant's Union representative was informed by the Board that unless he notified the Board within 10 days of the receipt of the Board's letter that Appellant either wished to pursue her appeal or was withdrawing it, the Board would dismiss the case.

The 10-day period has elapsed, and to date no statement whatsoever has been received by the Board concerning the above-captioned case.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the case is dismissed.
