

1 MR. WHITCOMB: That's correct.

2 MR. THEODORE: Okay. Then I guess we'll come
3 back at 12:30 if that's the case at this point.

4 MR. WILLIAMSON: Could we make it about quarter
5 of one. It's going to be awfully short and since you're
6 doing me a favor I'd hate to come back late.

7 THE HEARING OFFICER: Okay.

8 (Whereupon a short noon recess was taken.)

9 MR. THEODORE: Let's go back on the record.

10 THE HEARING OFFICER: Back on the record.

11 MR. WILLIAMSON: In off the record discussions
12 which took place in the presence of the Board member and
13 Counsel for the Board, the parties have or at least believe
14 they have reached an agreement settling this matter and
15 at this time Counsel for the Respondent will read or state
16 for the record what that agreement is and with - or my
17 agreement.

18 MR. WHITCOMB: In consideration of a motion by
19 Appellant to dismiss with prejudices appeal, Respondent
20 will stipulate to the following: Respondent will reclassify
21 Appellant to a Teacher IV at the incremental (phonetic)
22 step three within that pay range, incremental step three
23 within that pay range, effective the nearest administrative
24 date to March, following March 6th, 1975. Second, Re-
25 spondent will reclassify Appellant as a Teacher V at the

1 fifth incremental pay step within that range, effective
2 the nearest administrative date following 7-1-75.

3 MR. WILLIAMSON: And it is my understanding that
4 he will be made whole for the difference between - as a
5 result of this agreement, of the difference between what
6 he would have received had he been classified on those
7 dates then, what he actually did receive.

8 MR. WHITCOMB: That's correct, yes.

9 MR. WILLIAMSON: Mr. Larry Werner is in the
10 room presently, and he has authorized me to enter into
11 this settlement which will lead to the dismissal of this
12 appeal with prejudice. It is understood, however, that
13 this is a settlement and is not to be precedent for any
14 other case now pending before involving any client that
15 I represent or since as the record perhaps should show,
16 I am retained by Local 3271 of the Wisconsin Federation
17 of Teachers affiliated with the American Federation of
18 Teachers, AFL CIO and we do have matters that come before
19 the Board and do have matters tending before the Board
20 on issues that have been resolved in an accommodable
21 fashion. But with that understanding, as the last agree-
22 ment was, we are happy to conclude this matter on a settle-
23 ment basis.

24 THE HEARING OFFICER: If there is nothing else
25 to come before this hearing, then I declare this hearing
