

1 MS. DAUT: Okay. This is a stipulation which
2 will settle the case of Alfred Nesvold vs. Barbara
3 Thompson and I just read stipulation into the record.
4 "The parties hereto stipulate and agree to the following:
5 (1) Alfred Nesvold was hired as a Teacher II on August
6 22nd, 1973. (2) On October 5th, 1973, Mr. William English
7 (phonetic), Superintendent for Wisconsin School for the
8 Visually Handicapped and Mr. Nesvold's Supervisor wrote
9 a letter to Mr. Dirkgray (phonetic), Personnel Officer
10 for the Department of Public Instruction requesting that
11 Mr. Nesvold be reclassified as a Teacher IV or a Teacher
12 V based on a number of credits he had earned as indicated
13 by his transcripts. (3) On November 21st, 1973, Mr.
14 Dirkgray denied the October 5th, 1973, request for Mr.
15 Nesvold has sufficient credits to be classified as a
16 Teacher V as of November 21st, 1973, under the pay
17 schedule which existed at that time and as it was sub-
18 sequently interpreted by the State Personnel Board in
19 the VanLaanen Decision. (5) Therefore, it is stipulated
20 and agreed between the parties that Mr. Nesvold be re-
21 allocated to a Teacher V to be effective the nearest
22 administrative date following November 21st, 1973. (6)
23 Mr. Nesvold has sufficient credits to be classified as a
24 Teacher VI on January 19, 1975. (7) Therefore, it is
25 stipulated and agreed between the parties that Mr. Nesvold

1 be reallocated to a Teacher VI effective January 19th, 1975.
2 This stipulation is entered into solely for the purpose
3 of settlement of this case and is not binding, applicable,
4 and sets precedent for any other appeal involving any of
5 the parties to this agreement or any other appeal involving
6 similar facts.

7 MR. WILLIAMSON: It's my understanding that the
8 intent of that is that he would be put in the same posi-
9 tion as anybody else financially as of the dates in ques-
10 tion in those teaching classifications.

11 MS. DAUT: That's right. He will be put in the
12 position of Teacher V as of the nearest administrative
13 date following November 21st, 1973, financially and as a
14 Teacher VI, he will be compensated as a Teacher VI as of
15 January 19th, 1975.

16 MR. WILLIAMSON: Okay. Mr. Nesvold is in the
17 room and I have been authorized by him to accept that
18 stipulation and settlement of this case and I hereby do
19 so on his behalf.

20 THE HEARING OFFICER: This disposes of the
21 Nesvold Case. Then?

22 MR. WILLIAMSON: Yes?

23 THE HEARING OFFICER: According to this stipula-
24 tion. Now does someone care to make a statement about the
25 Tolla Case?
