
The May 18th decision contained a finding that prior to his last day of work "the appellant was considered to have performed his work in a competent manner." However, the hearing was limited to the question of subject matter jurisdiction. In the Board's opinion the respondent should be allowed to be heard on the substantive questions, before the case is fully decided.

ORDER

Appellant's motion for an order to dispose of Case No. 76-238 is denied.
