ORDER

This case was originally dismissed by the Personnel Board on June 30, 1976, at the request of the appellant. The appellant subsequently requested that the appeal be reopened. A hearing was held on that request, and the Board denied it in an Order dated June 16, 1978. The appellant then filed on July 6, 1978, a request for rehearing.

Section 227.12(3), Wis. Stats., provides that a rehearing will be granted only on the basis of:

- "(a) Some material error of law.
- (b) Some material error of fact.
- (c) The discovery of new evidence sufficiently strong to reverse or modify the Order, and which would not have been previously determined by due diligence."

The appellant in support of his rehearing request has expressed his disagreement with much of the June 16, 1978, decision. However, it is for the most part a repetition of points raised at the hearing or which appellant had an opportunity to raise at the hearing. There is nothing presented which leads the Commission to conclude that any of the three criteria set forth in § 227.12(3) have been established,

and the request for rehearing accordingly is denied.
