DECISION
 AND
 ORDER

This matter is before the Commission at the final step in the non-contract grievance procedure. The appellant seeks reimbursement for the use of his motorcycle on state business. At a prehearing conference on April 13, 1981, the parties agreed to hold further proceedings in abeyance "pending legislative action on proposed legislation which could resolve the subject matter of this dispute." The proposed legislation failed to pass, and respondent objected to the jurisdiction of the Commission to hear the matter, arguing that it lacks statutory authorization to grant the relief requested by the appellant.

Reimbursement for travel expenses of state officers and employes is governed by Ch. 20, Wis. Stats., and is the responsibility of the Secretary of the Department of Employment Relations. As a consequence, there can be no allegation of a violation of civil service law (Subch. II, Ch. 230, Wis. Stats.) or involvement of the administrator of the Division of Personnel that would provide a basis for an appeal to the Commission under the non-contract grievance procedure. Gohl v. 
ORDER
