DECISION
AND
ORDER

In a letter filed with the Commission on August 17, 1981, the appellant sought to appeal his 1981 performance evaluation that had been completed by supervisor. Appellant argued that the evaluation was inaccurate. After being advised that the Commission might lack the authority to hear his appeal, appellant filed a letter in which he argued that the employees in his office were not provided with the same employe performance evaluation program as other State employees, contrary to s.230.37(1), Wis. Stats.


After considering the appellant's argument, the Commission concludes that it lacks jurisdiction over his appeal. Review of a performance evaluation is not included within the jurisdiction granted the Commission in s.230.45, Wis. Stats.


ORDER
