#89-1355 - Kenneth Vander Zanden v. DILHR and Wisconsin
Personnel Commission (L.C. No. 88 CV 1223)

Before Moser, P.J., Sullivan and Fine, JJ.

Kenneth Vander Zanden appeals from the circuit court's judgment that affirmed a decision of the Wisconsin Personnel Commission. Based upon our review of the briefs and record, at conference, we conclude that this case is appropriate for summary disposition. See Rule 809.21, Stats. We affirm the circuit court's judgment.

Vander Zanden sought circuit court review of a commission decision dismissing his complaint filed under the Employee

Protection (or "Whistleblower") Act, secs. 230.80-230.89, Stats. The circuit court affirmed the commission's determination, and this appeal followed. The memorandum decision of the circuit court is an excellent analysis of the law and a proper application of the law to the facts of the case. We adopt the circuit court's decision.

Upon the foregoing reasons,

IT IS ORDERED that the trial court's judgment is affirmed.
