This matter is before the Commission on appellant's "petition for limited rehearing on issue of meaning of 'remand' regarding suspension grievance," filed June 20, 1994. The Commission gave respondent until July 1, 1994, to file a response. Respondent did not file a response.

By way of background, the Commission entered an "Interim Decision and Order" in this matter¹ on May 27, 1994.² This decision concluded that respondent "failed to provide a predisciplinary procedure consistent with the requirements of the due process clause of the Fourteenth Amendment to the U.S. Constitution, and these suspensions must be rejected." (Conclusion of Law #3, p.12, proposed decision and order which was adopted by the Commission in its final order). The Commission's order rejected the suspensions and "remanded to respondent for action in accordance with this decision." (proposed decision and order, p.38).

In her petition for limited rehearing, appellant contends that the order should be interpreted to require respondent on remand to pay her the amount of pay lost (plus interest), as opposed to simply holding a new predisciplianry hearing on remand,³ and concludes that the Commission should "clarify the

Remand Order by requiring the payment of \$1,281.92 to the complainant." Petition, p.5

Since respondent failed to file a response in opposition to the petition, the Commission will grant it and amends its interim order entered May 27, 1994, to require that respondent pay appellant \$1,281.92 in back pay and interest.
