**ORDER SETTING ASIDE DECISION ON MOTION TO CLARIFY**

On March 11, 2016, the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission rejected the State of Wisconsin Department of Corrections' decision to discharge Mathew Seiler and converted the discharge to a 10-day suspension. A dispute subsequently arose as to the implementation of the March 11 decision and, on April 19, 2016, the Commission issued a Decision on Motion to Clarify which addressed that dispute. The State of Wisconsin Department of Corrections subsequently sought circuit court review of the April 19, 2016 decision. Thereafter, the Department of Corrections, the Commission, and Seiler entered into a settlement agreement. Pursuant to the terms of that agreement, the Commission now makes and issues the following

The April 19, 2016 Decision on Motion to Clarify is set aside.
