MEMORANDUM ACCOMPANYING ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO DISMISS

Staveness filed his appeal pursuant to § 230.44(1)(c), Stats., which gives the Commission authority among other matters to determine whether a disciplinary reduction in base pay was for just cause. First, it is apparent that the dispute over whether Staveness is entitled to add-on pay is not disciplinary in nature. Second, denial of add-on pay is not a reduction in base pay. Therefore, we lack jurisdiction over the appeal and it is dismissed.
