**ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL**

On November 17, 2014, Darrin Schultz filed an appeal with the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission alleging that the State of Wisconsin, Department of Corrections had suspended him for three days without just cause. The matter was scheduled and rescheduled for hearing and there were settlement talks between the parties.

On November 23, 2015, the state asked the Commission to dismiss the appeal for lack of prosecution. On December 7, 2015, the Commission advised both Schultz and Representative Kraemer that the appeal would be dismissed unless, on or before December 21, 2015, the Commission received a request that the appeal proceed to hearing. No request was received.
