DECISION AND ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO DISMISS

On August 13, 2021, Stacey Daigle filed an appeal with the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission asserting that the State of Wisconsin Department of Corrections (DOC) had retaliated against her for raising safety concerns at Lincoln Hills/Copper Lake School and thereby abused discretion in violation of Sec. 230.44(1)(d), Stats. On September 10, 2021, DOC filed a motion to dismiss contending that Sec. 230.44(1)(d), Stats. only applies to hiring decisions. Daigle filed a response on September 21, 2021.

Having considered the matter, the Commission concludes that it does lack jurisdiction under Sec. 230.44(1)(d), Stats. the consider the merits of the appeal.

The motion to dismiss is granted and the appeal is dismissed.
