ORDER DENYING PETITION FOR REHEARING

On April 14, 2023, the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission issued a Decision and Order Granting Motion to Dismiss as to an appeal filed by Austin Weidner against the State of Wisconsin Department of Corrections.

On May 2, 2023, Weidner filed a Petition for Rehearing pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.49 asserting that the Commission had made certain errors of fact and law in its April 14, 2023, Decision and Order. The State of Wisconsin Department of Corrections filed a response opposing the Petition on May 11, 2023, and Weidner replied on May 12, 2023.
