CERTIFICATION OF REPRESENTATIVE

Pursuant to a Direction of Election previously issued by it in the above-captioned matter, the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission, on September 5, 2024, conducted an election, pursuant to § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act, to determine whether employees of the Town of Dover, in the collective bargaining unit set forth in the Commission's Direction, desired to be represented by the International Association of Fire Fighters, for the purpose of collective bargaining with the Town of Dover.

The result of the election was as follows:

1.	Total number eligible to vote	6
2.	Total ballots cast	6
3.	Total valid ballots counted	6
4.	Ballots cast for International Association of Fire Fighters,	6
5.	Ballots cast for no representation	0

NOW, THEREFORE, by virtue of and pursuant to the power vested in the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission by § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act;

IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED that the International Association of Fire Fighters, has been selected by a majority of all eligible employees who voted at said election in the collective

bargaining unit consisting of full-time professional employees whose primary function includes but is not limited to fire fighting, fire prevention, and emergency medical services, excluding chief officers, as their representative; and that pursuant to the provisions of § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act, the International Association of Fire Fighters is the exclusive collective bargaining representative of all such employees for the purpose of collective bargaining with the Town of Dover.
