## **CERTIFICATION OF REPRESENTATIVE**

Pursuant to a Direction of Election previously issued by it in the above-captioned matter, the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission, on December 23, 2024, conducted an election, pursuant to § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act, to determine whether employees of the Darlington Community School District, in the collective bargaining unit set forth in the Commission's Direction, desired to be represented by the Darlington Education Association, WEAC Region 6, for the purpose of collective bargaining with the Darlington Community School District.

IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED that the Darlington Education Association, WEAC Region 6 has been selected by at least fifty-one percent (51%) of all eligible employees in the collective

bargaining unit consisting of all regular full-time and regular part-time professional teaching staff with no administrative duties, excluding support staff, confidential, supervisory and managerial employees., as their representative; and that pursuant to the provisions of 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act said Labor Organization is the exclusive collective bargaining representative of all such employees for the purpose of collective bargaining with the Darlington Community School District.
