Pursuant to a Direction of Election previously issued by it in the above-captioned matter, the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission, on February 18, 2025 and April 17, 2025, conducted an election, pursuant to § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act, to determine whether employees of the Port Edwards School District, in the collective bargaining unit set forth in the Commission's Direction, desired to be represented by the Port Edwards Education Association, WEAC Region 2, for the purpose of collective bargaining with the Port Edwards School District.

IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED that the Port Edwards Education Association, WEAC Region 2 has been selected by at least fifty-one percent (51%) of all eligible employees in the collective bargaining unit consisting of all full-time and part-time (50% or more of time teaching) contract teaching employees, guidance employees, and librarians in the Port Edwards School District, excluding the superintendent, principal, administrative and clerical employees, nurses, maintenance employees, building and grounds employees, kitchen and cafeteria employees, noncontract and substitute teaching employees and all other employees., as their representative; and that pursuant to the provisions of § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act said Labor Organization is the exclusive collective bargaining representative of all such employees for the purpose of collective bargaining with the Port Edwards School District.
