CERTIFICATION OF REPRESENTATIVE

Pursuant to a Direction of Election previously issued by it in the above-captioned matter, the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission, on March 13 and 27, 2025, conducted an election, pursuant to § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act, to determine whether employees of the Pulaski Community School District, in the collective bargaining unit set forth in the Commission's Direction, desired to be represented by the Pulaski Education Association, WEAC Region 3, for the purpose of collective bargaining with the Pulaski Community School District.

The result of the election was as follows:

1.	Total number eligible to vote	327
2.	Total ballots cast	248
3.	Total valid ballots counted	248
4.	Ballots cast for Pulaski Education Association, WEAC Region 3,	246
5.	Ballots cast for no representation	2

NOW, THEREFORE, by virtue of and pursuant to the power vested in the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission by § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act;

IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED that the Pulaski Education Association, WEAC Region 3 has been selected by at least fifty-one percent (51%) of all eligible employees in the collective bargaining unit consisting of all employees classified as teachers, psychologists, therapists, nurses and social workers; excluding administrators, administrative assistants, principals, assistant principals, District directors, District supervisors, District coordinators, educational interns, non instructional personnel and persons employed on a per diem basis., as their representative; and that pursuant to the provisions of § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act said Labor Organization is the exclusive collective bargaining representative of all such employees for the purpose of collective bargaining with the Pulaski Community School District.
