**CERTIFICATION OF REPRESENTATIVE**

Pursuant to a Direction of Election previously issued by it in the above-captioned matter, the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission, on June 5, 2025, conducted an election, pursuant to § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act, to determine whether employees of the Mercer Sanitary District No. 1, in the collective bargaining unit set forth in the Commission's Direction, desired to be represented by the International Union of Operating Engineers, Local 139 for the purpose of collective bargaining with the Mercer Sanitary District No. 1.

The result of the election was as follows:

5.	Ballots cast for no representation	0

NOW, THEREFORE, by virtue of and pursuant to the power vested in the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission by § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act;

IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED that the International Union of Operating Engineers, Local 139 has been selected by at least fifty-one percent (51%) of all eligible employees in the collective bargaining unit consisting of all regular full-time and regular part-time sanitary workers employed by the Mercer Sanitary District No. 1, excluding all supervisory, managerial, clerical and confidential employees, as their representative; and that pursuant to the provisions of § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act said Labor Organization is the exclusive collective bargaining representative of all such employees for the purpose of collective bargaining with the Mercer Sanitary District No. 1.
