CERTIFICATION OF REPRESENTATIVE

Pursuant to a Direction of Election previously issued by it in the above-captioned matter, the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission, on March 9, 2026, conducted an election, pursuant to § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act, to determine whether employees of Clark County, in the collective bargaining unit set forth in the Commission's Direction, desired to be represented by the Clark County Deputy Sheriff's Office, for the purpose of collective bargaining with Clark County.

The result of the election was as follows:

NOW, THEREFORE, by virtue of and pursuant to the power vested in the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission by § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act;

IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED that the Clark County Deputy Sheriff's Office has been selected by a majority of all eligible employees who voted at said election in the collective

bargaining unit consisting of all regular full-time and regular part-time employees with position titles of Courthouse Security Deputy, Detective, Drug Investigator, Patrol Deputy, Patrol Sergeant, Recreational Patrol Deputy, K9 Patrol Deputy and School Resource Officer excluding all other Clark County Sheriff's Office positions not listed including: the Sheriff, Chief Deputy, Reserve Patrol Deputy, supervisors, managers and confidential/administrative employees., as their representative; and that pursuant to the provisions of § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act the Clark County Deputy Sheriff's Office is the exclusive collective bargaining representative of all such employees for the purpose of collective bargaining with Clark County.
