CERTIFICATION OF ELECTION RESULTS

Pursuant to a Direction of Election previously issued by it in the above-captioned matter, the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission, on March 12, 2026, conducted an election, pursuant to § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act, to determine whether employees of Richland County, in the collective bargaining unit set forth in the Commission's Direction, desired to be represented by the SEIU Wisconsin, for the purpose of collective bargaining with Richland County.

The result of the election was as follows:

NOW, THEREFORE, by virtue of and pursuant to the power vested in the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission by § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act;

IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED that the SEIU Wisconsin has been selected by a majority of all eligible employees who voted at said election in the collective bargaining unit consisting of All

regular full-time, part-time, and on-call Emergency Medical Technicians, Advanced Emergency Medical Technicians, and Emergency Medical Responders, excluding supervisory, managerial and confidential employees, as their representative; and that pursuant to the provisions of § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act the SEIU Wisconsin, is the exclusive collective bargaining representative of all such employees for the purpose of collective bargaining with Richland County.
