**DIRECTION OF NEW ELECTION**

Pursuant to a January 29, 2026 Request for Annual Certification Election, the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission having on April 28, 2022 conducted an election pursuant to § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act, to determine if the employees in the DPW and clerical bargaining unit of the City of Schofield wanted to continue to be represented by Teamsters Local 662, for the purposes of collective bargaining; and a timely objection to the election results having been filed by Teamsters Local 662, asserting that employees did not receive notice of the election and requesting that a new election be conducted; and the City of Schofield having no objection; and the Commission having considered the matter and concluded that a new election should be conducted;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is

**DIRECTED**

That a new election shall be conducted by secret mail ballot under the direction of the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission among all employees of the City of Schofield in the DPW and clerical bargaining unit who were employed on January 29, 2026, except such employees as may prior to the election leave or be removed from the bargaining unit, for the purpose of determining whether at least fifty-one percent (51%) of the employees in the bargaining unit want to continue to be represented by Teamsters Local 662, for the purpose of collective bargaining with the City of Schofield.
