


IT IS STIPULATED by and between the parties hereto as follows:


That in full settlement of all of the claims of the respective parties hereto:

1. That the appellant shall commence employment at the Superior office of the D.V.R. at a category of Supervisor I, at the maximum pay range for that position.
2. That he shall forfeit any back pay as the result of his suspension from employment.
3. That he shall retain any unemployment compensation paid to him as a result of said loss of employment.
4. That he shall serve a six month's probationary period in such employment.
5. That he shall retain all accumulated sick leave, seniority, vacation rights and any other prior employment rights due him by reason of his employment with the State of Wisconsin.
6. That this agreement shall be effective as of April 19, 1976.
7. That the parties agree that an order may be entered by the State Personnel Board consistent with the terms of this agreement.
