ORDER

This investigation request involves the termination of a probationary employe as an Attorney 12 hearing officer (unemployment compensation). She alleged that she was terminated as a result of pro-employer bias by her supervisor. She subsequently was rehired by DILHR but she alleges that she was not fully reinstated.

The Board is aware that the Senate Committee on Agriculture, Labor, and Aging has been conducting hearings that according to media accounts deal at least in part with an investigation into the alleged bias of her supervisor. The complainant maintains that this investigation has not considered her complaint. However, to the extent that the committee makes any findings on the alleged bias of appellant's supervisor, that may have a very direct bearing on her complaint. The Board is reluctant to make any decision on further action that conceivably could cover much of the ground covered by the Senate Committee without having the benefit of any findings it makes. Therefore, the Board Secretary will request a copy of the committee report, and, when received, distribute copies to the Board members and the parties to this investigation request.
