
ORDER

The Commission issued Interim Decisions and Orders dated June 3, 1980, and April 23, 1981, in which it ordered the parties to provide each other with discovery requested in the course of investigating the matters alleged in the appeal, and issued an Order on June 12, 1981, in which the parties were ordered to comply in full with the Interim Decision and Order of April 23, 1981. The appellant has stated that he refuses to comply with these orders on the ground that he did not wish to divulge the name of a potential witness because of the alleged likelihood of retaliation, notwithstanding the facts that the Commission has entered an Order forbidding retaliation against such witness, and the allegation of retaliation is conclusory in nature. The Commission finds that the appellant is in default and orders this appeal dismissed.




