ORDER GRANTING PETITION FOR REHEARING

On February 11, 2021, the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission issued a Decision and Order concluding that the involuntary transfer of Jonas Trochinski did not violate Wis. Stat. § 230.44(1)(a). On February 18, 2021, Trochinski filed a petition for rehearing pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.49, asserting that the Commission had made errors of fact and law. That same day, Respondents filed a reply opposing the petition.

Having considered the matter, the Commission concludes that the petition should be granted for the purposes of conducting a hearing to determine if it made any error of fact of law.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Commission makes and issues the following:

ORDER

The petition for rehearing is granted.
