ORDER DENYING REQUEST FOR RECONSIDERATION

On October 26, 2021, the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission issued a Decision and Order Granting in Part and Denying in Part Motion to Dismiss. On November 2, 2021, the University of Wisconsin-Madison (UW) filed a request for reconsideration as to the portion of the Decision and Order that allows Christopher Heidel to proceed to hearing as to an allegation that his furlough was a disciplinary suspension. On November 16, 2021, Heidel filed a statement in opposition to the UW request.

Having considered the request, the Commission has concluded that there is no persuasive basis for granting the request.

The request for reconsideration is denied.
