**ORDER DENYING PETITION FOR REHEARING**

On August 25 2022, the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission issued a Decision and Order Granting Motion to Dismiss concluding that it did not have jurisdiction over an appeal filed by Sheila Easley.

On September 12, 2022, Easley filed a Petition for Rehearing pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.49 asserting that the Commission had made certain errors of fact and law in its August 25, 2022 Decision and Order.
