ORDER GRANTING PETITION FOR REHEARING

On January 15, 2025, the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission issued a Decision and Order concluding that the three-day suspension of Bradley Lewin by the State of Wisconsin Department of Corrections be modified to a Letter of Expectation and that Lewin be made whole in all other regards, pursuant to Wis. Admin. Code § ERC 94.07. On February 3, 2025, the Department of Corrections filed a petition for rehearing pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.49, asserting that the Commission had made material errors of law or fact in its Decision and Order. Lewin did not file a response to the petition by the given deadline of February 17, 2025.

Having considered the matter, the Commission concludes that the petition should be granted for the purpose of determining if the Commission made a material error of law or fact.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Commission makes and issues the following:

ORDER

The petition for rehearing is granted.
