ORDER DENYING PETITION FOR REHEARING

On May 16, 2025, the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission issued a Decision and Order affirming the one-day suspension of Leah Hubbard (Hubbard) by the State of Wisconsin Department of Administration (DOA). On June 4, 2025, Hubbard filed a Petition for Rehearing pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.49, asserting that the Commission had made errors of law or fact in its May 16, 2025, Decision and Order.
