ORDER DENYING PETITION FOR REHEARING

On October 27, 2025, the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission issued a Decision and Order modifying the discharge of Anthony Haliwell by the State of Wisconsin Department of Corrections (DOC) to reinstatement without backpay and a demotion to the position of Sergeant. On October 28, 2025, Haliwell filed a Petition for Rehearing pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.49, asserting that the Commission had made certain errors of law or fact in its October 27, 2025, Decision and Order. On November 13, 2025, Haliwell filed a Brief in Support of his Petition for Hearing. The DOC did not file a response by the given deadline of November 17, 2025, and the matter became ripe for Commission consideration.

Having considered the matter, the Commission concludes that it did not make any errors of law or fact in its October 27, 2025, Decision and Order.

The Petition for Rehearing is denied.
