ORDER DENYING PETITION FOR REHEARING

On March 2, 2026, Examiner Larson issued a Proposed Decision and Order, modifying the five-day suspension of Marcus King (King) by the State of Wisconsin Department of Corrections (DOC) to a three-day suspension, and ordering he be made whole for the difference with interest. On March 9, 2026, both King and the DOC filed objections to the proposed decision.

On March 26, 2026, the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission issued a Final Decision and Order affirming the five-day suspension of King by the DOC. On April 14, 2026, King filed a Petition for Rehearing, asserting the Commission had made certain errors of law or facts in its Final Decision and Order. DOC filed a reply to the petition for rehearing on April 27, 2026, and the matter became ripe for Commission consideration.

Having considered the matter, the Commission is satisfied that it did not make any material error of law or fact in its Final Decision and Order issued on March 26, 2026.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is:

The Petition for Rehearing is denied.
