ORDER DENYING PETITION FOR REHEARING

On May 1, 2026, the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission issued a Final Decision and Order affirming the five-day suspension of Amy Pflueger by the State of Wisconsin Department of Corrections. On May 20, 2026, Pflueger filed a Petition for Rehearing, asserting the Commission had made certain errors of law or fact in its Decision and Order and that new relevant evidence had been discovered. DOC filed a response to the petition for rehearing on June 2, 2026, and the matter became ripe for Commission consideration.

Having considered the matter, the Commission is satisfied that it did not make any material error of law or fact in its May 1, 2026, Decision and Order and that any new evidence which could not have been previously discovered by due diligence is not sufficiently strong to reverse or modify the Decision and Order.

The Petition for Rehearing is denied.
